Registration Terms & Conditions

Version 1.1 — Effective Aug 2026 — Applies to all HDTA competition, squad, club championship, tournament, social or other tennis related event registrations at Castle Hill Tennis Centre and Dural Tennis Centre

This document sets out the terms and conditions that apply when you register for any Hills District Tennis Association Inc. (HDTA) activity, including competitions, squads, club championships, tournaments, social tennis, and other tennis-related events, at Castle Hill Tennis Centre or Dural Tennis Centre. By submitting the registration form, you (or, if you are registering a minor, the minor's parent or guardian) agree to be bound by this document and each of the specific acknowledgements set out on the registration form itself.

Note: HDTA does not itself provide coaching. Coaching at each venue is delivered by independently contracted coaching operators under a separate agreement with HDTA, and is not covered by this document. If you register for coaching, that operator's own terms will apply.

1. Risk Warning — Recreational Services (Civil Liability Act 2002 (NSW))

HDTA provides competition, squad, club championship, tournament, social play, and other tennis-related services, which are recreational activities. Participation in tennis carries inherent risks, including but not limited to:

- Collision with other players, the net post, fencing, or court furniture
- Being struck by a ball or racquet
- Slips, trips, or falls, including on wet, uneven, or damaged court surfaces
- Sprains, strains, fractures, and other injuries from sudden movement, overexertion, or repetitive play
- Heat-related illness during play in hot conditions
- Injury arising from equipment failure or misuse
- Injury caused by the acts or omissions of other players, coaches, or spectators

These risks exist even where HDTA and its officials, volunteers and contractors exercise reasonable care. This warning is given under the Civil Liability Act 2002 (NSW) so that you are aware of these risks before participating in any HDTA activity, competition, squad, club championship, tournament, social tennis, or court hire.

2. Terms of Registration

By ticking this box, you (or, for a minor, the minor's parent or guardian) confirm each of the following:

Risk warning:

- I have read and understood the risk warning in Section 1 above, and I (or the registering minor) voluntarily accept the risks of participating in tennis activities at HDTA venues.
- I confirm that I am (or the registering minor is) medically fit to participate, or have sought medical advice confirming fitness to do so.

Emergency contact and medical information:

- I have provided a current emergency contact name and telephone number.

- (Optional field, separate from this tick) I have disclosed any medical conditions, allergies, or other information relevant to safety that HDTA staff or first aiders should be aware of in an emergency.
- I authorise HDTA staff or first aiders to arrange first aid, call an ambulance, or seek other emergency medical treatment for the registrant if I (or the registrant, if an adult) cannot be reached in a timely manner.

HDTA policies:

- I have read and agree to abide by the HDTA Code of Behaviour (hdta.org.au/hdta-policies) and the applicable HDTA Competition Rules (hdta.org.au/competitions/competition-rules).

Tennis Australia and Tennis NSW policies:

- I acknowledge that HDTA is affiliated with Tennis NSW and Tennis Australia, and that I am bound by their current policies, including the Tennis Australia Member Protection Policy and Safeguarding Children Code of Conduct, available at tennis.com.au/about-us/safeguarding/policies-compliance.

Privacy:

- I acknowledge the HDTA privacy collection notice (Section 6 below) and the HDTA Privacy Policy at hdta.org.au/privacy-policy.

Payment:

- I authorise payment of the applicable registration/activity fee via HDTA's nominated payment provider (Square), and agree to that provider's payment terms.

☐ I have read and agree to the HDTA Registration Terms & Conditions, including the risk warning above, HDTA and Tennis Australia/Tennis NSW policies, privacy notice, and payment terms, and I authorise emergency medical treatment if required.

3. Photography, Video and Media Consent

HDTA may take photographs or video during HDTA activities, competitions, and events at Castle Hill Tennis Centre and Dural Tennis Centre, and may use these on HDTA's website, social media channels, and in printed or digital marketing material.

☐ I consent to photographs/video of myself (or the registering minor) being taken at HDTA activities and used on HDTA's website, social media, and marketing materials.

You may withdraw this consent at any time by emailing admin@hdta.org.au. Withdrawal does not affect material already published before the request was received. If you would like to consent to some uses but not others (for example, website only, not social media), contact admin@hdta.org.au to arrange this — the standard form offers a single combined consent for simplicity.

4. Draw Page — Publication of Contact Number

HDTA publishes competition draws, including player names and contact numbers, on a public results page to help players arrange match times. This is a separate consent from Section 3 (photography) above.

☐ I consent to my first name and last initial (or, for a registering minor, the minor's first name and last initial) being published on the public HDTA competition draw page, together with the mobile number provided at registration, for the purpose of arranging matches. The mobile number provided must belong to a person aged 18 or over. Where the registrant is a minor, the parent or guardian must provide their own mobile number for this purpose, not the minor's.

If you do not consent, you must still provide a contact number for competition administration purposes — it will not be published, and you will need to arrange match scheduling through the HDTA office instead, during HDTA office hours as published.

5. Marketing Communications Consent

This consent is separate from operational communications (e.g. draw notifications, court closures, competition updates), which HDTA will send to registered participants regardless, as they are necessary to deliver the service you have registered for.

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6. Privacy Collection Notice

HDTA collects personal information (including name, date of birth, contact details, and, where provided, medical information) to administer your registration, membership, competitions, and club communications. This information may be disclosed to:

- HDTA's registration and payment platforms (Jotform, Square, Stripe)
- Tennis NSW / Tennis Australia, where required for affiliation, insurance, or competition purposes
- HDTA's bookkeeping and administrative systems
- Independently contracted coaching operators at each venue, where required for grading, squad or other tennis related purposes.

HDTA does not sell or disclose your personal information to third parties for their own marketing purposes. You may request access to or correction of your personal information, or raise a privacy concern, by contacting the HDTA Operations Manager at admin@hdta.org.au. Full details are set out in the HDTA Privacy Policy at hdta.org.au/privacy-policy.

7. Registration of a Minor (Under 18)

Where the registrant is under 18 years of age, all consents and acknowledgements in this document must be given by a parent or legal guardian on the minor's behalf, not by the minor. The registration form will request the parent/guardian's name, relationship to the registrant, and contact details.

- ☐ I confirm I am the parent or legal guardian of the registering minor, I give each of the consents and acknowledgements in this document on their behalf, and I confirm the date of birth provided for the registering minor is accurate for the purposes of correct age-grading in junior competitions.
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8. General

HDTA may update this document from time to time to reflect changes in law, policy, or club operations. The version and effective date at the top of this document indicate the version you are agreeing to. Continued participation in HDTA activities after a material update will be treated as acceptance of the updated terms, and updates will be notified via the HDTA website and/or club communications.

This document does not limit any rights you may have under the Australian Consumer Law or other applicable legislation that cannot be excluded by agreement.

Competition-specific eligibility, season commitment, and refund/withdrawal terms are set out separately in the applicable HDTA Competition Terms & Conditions for the activity you are registering for, and apply in addition to this document.
